

## **Volunteer Maths or English Tutor**

## **Our mission**

Action Tutoring supports young people facing socio-economic disadvantage to achieve a meaningful level of academic attainment, with a view to enabling them to progress in education, employment or training. We do this by partnering high-quality volunteer tutors with pupils to increase their subject knowledge, confidence and study skills.

## The role

Action Tutoring partners with primary and secondary schools to deliver tutoring programmes for pupils preparing for their GCSEs and SATs in English and maths. A 'programme' means a term of tutoring at a partner school, with sessions at the same time each week.

As a volunteer, you will be able to choose which programme you are allocated to. All tutoring takes place at school and you will be working in a team alongside other volunteer tutors. Action Tutoring provides the content, your role is to deliver the tutoring sessions. Working either one-to-one or with small groups of pupils to help improve their academic ability, develop their confidence in your chosen subject and to help them work on their study skills.
