

## What is it like to work at Action Tutoring?

### Working Style

- We'll give you the warmest welcome and provide you with a great **induction and training**. As an ambitious charity, sometimes you'll have to dig into projects or tasks right away, but there's plenty of support available from our brilliant team.
- It doesn't matter what kind of barriers and challenges we're facing, we are **adaptable** and strive to make things work so that our pupils get the best quality tutoring.
- At times, it can be really busy, but we believe in our mission and **we work as a team** to ensure that the show goes on.
- If you're based in, or close to, one of our main regions **outside of London**, you'll have the opportunity to join a **co-working space** with other team members on a **monthly** basis. For staff based **in London, you have one designated office day per week**. Depending on the availability of desk space, there may be options to come into the office more often. - Again, if you live in, or near, one of our main regions, we'll encourage you to get together for a **social event** at celebratory times (e.g. the festive period

or at the end of the academic year). We also frequently run virtual socials!

- **The whole team meets virtually once per month** to ensure that everyone is up to date with what the charity has been up to.
- One of our highlights of the year is our **team days** when the entire team comes together for a few days in person. A great moment to connect, update and learn from each other. Additionally, your team will meet twice per year for their own team days.
- We encourage people from **different departments to chat and connect**. Having time to get to know colleagues is highly valued. We do this through our 'buddy' systems, optional lunchtime catch-ups or (optional) randomly created chat roulette.
- We use Slack to share updates, ask questions and **stay connected** as a geographically dispersed team. Some of us love sharing our photos on Slack: whether pictures of our pet, your child's first day of school, or a snapshot of your weekend - if you're happy to share it, we want to see it!
- We love sharing our skills, passions and interests with colleagues.
- Learning and development doesn't end at your team; ranging from wellbeing to data, inclusion and diversity to policy, we've got a variety of **working groups** you can join to expand your wider skills and knowledge.
