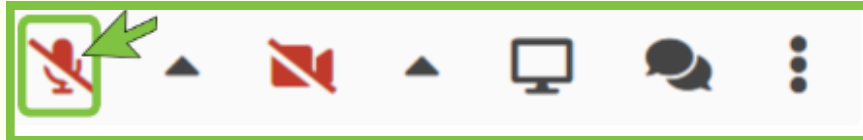

1. Reducing background noise

In most cases, background noise shouldn't be a significant issue. However, if you do encounter it, you can minimize it by simply asking your pupils to mute their microphones when they are not speaking.

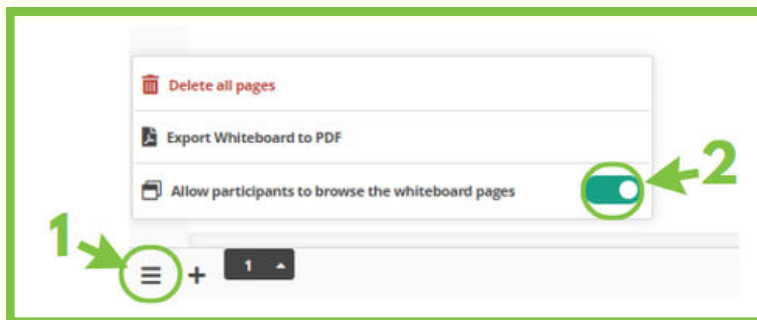


2. Allowing pupils to browse slides

By default, pupils will be limited to viewing the same slide as you. Certain sections of the template will contain sections for pupils to work independently.

To allow this:

1. Click the **three vertical lines** in the bottom left corner of the screen.
2. Click the button next to 'Allow participants to browse the whiteboard pages'.



When proceeding to a group activity or reading, **untick this box** to bring pupils back to the same slide you have selected!



3. Useful Vedamo tools



Use the **'Hand'** tool to navigate the free space around the session template.



Use the **'Pointer'** tool to highlight a section of the template. Your pupils can't see your mouse by default.



Use the **'Center canvas'** tool if you can't see the session template.



If you finish all the activities, please don't close the session early. You can load another session template from the **Session templates menu**.
